The secret ingredient is the **Laraha orange**.

Centuries ago, Spanish settlers brought Valencia orange trees to Curaçao. While the island's dry climate prevented the fruit from becoming sweet enough to eat, something remarkable happened—the peels became intensely aromatic.

Today, those dried peels remain the signature ingredient in Genuine Curaçao Liqueur.
