Disney Lookout Cay at Lighthouse Point is Disney Cruise Line's newest island destination, located on the southern tip of **Eleuthera, Bahamas**. Opened in **2024**, Lookout Cay offers a very different experience from Castaway Cay. While Castaway Cay is designed around classic beach fun and Disney recreation, Lookout Cay celebrates the rich culture, art, music, and natural beauty of The Bahamas.

Disney worked closely with Bahamian artists, historians, and local communities to create a destination that feels authentically Bahamian while still delivering the exceptional guest experience Disney is known for.

The result is one of the most unique cruise destinations in the Caribbean—where breathtaking beaches meet colorful culture and conservation.

Where Do Cruise Ships Dock?



Disney ships dock directly alongside the island using a modern cruise pier.

After walking ashore, guests arrive at a beautifully designed welcome area before making their way to the main resort via a scenic walking path or complimentary tram.

The arrival area includes:

The walk to the main beach area is approximately **10–15 minutes**, or you can ride the complimentary tram.

Weather Throughout the Year

Lookout Cay enjoys beautiful Bahamian weather year-round.

Winter (December – February)

- Highs: 73–78°F (23–26°C)

Spring (March – May)

- Highs: 77–84°F (25–29°C)

Summer (June – August)

- Highs: 86–90°F (30–32°C)

Fall (September – November)

- Highs: 82–87°F (28–31°C)

Trade winds provide pleasant conditions throughout the year.

Hurricane Season

The Atlantic hurricane season officially runs from:

June 1 – November 30

Peak activity generally occurs during:

- August
- September
- October

Disney Cruise Line closely monitors tropical weather and adjusts itineraries when necessary.

Travel insurance is always recommended.



Getting Around

Transportation options include:

- Walking paths
- Complimentary tram service

Guests can either enjoy the scenic walk from the pier or ride the tram to the main beach areas.
